## Fall Product:



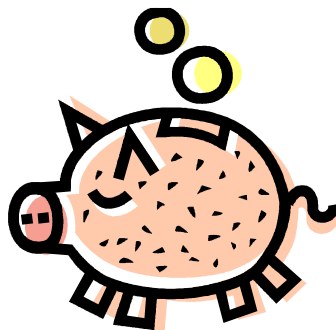
